► FOUNDATIONAL STAGE:

3 YEARS OF PRE-SCHOOL (AGE 3 TO 6) /
GRADES 1-2 (AGE 6 TO 8)

It focuses on developing a child who is an enquirer, a thinker, a collaborator and a problem solver. It's a program that develops individuality, creativity and self-directed learners. Art, music, drama, story-telling, puppetry and problem solving techniques form part of the Co-Curricular activities as the child moves to Grades 1-2. Aimed at providing sensory nourishment, these activities inspire students to try new tasks and accept new challenges.





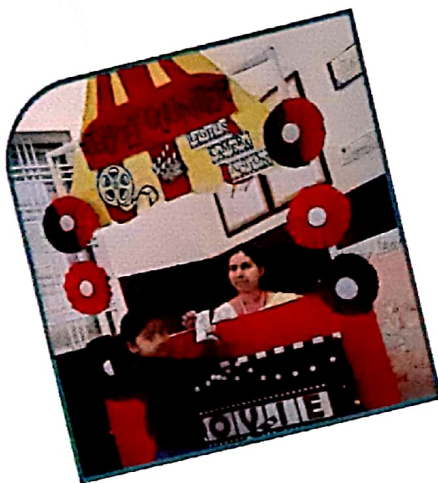
▶ **PREPARATORY STAGE:**
AGE 8 TO 11 GRADES 3 TO 5

Here, active learning takes place through auditory, visual and kinesthetic teaching aids and methods within the preparatory stage framework. A balance of curricular and extra-curricular activities help students develop multiple skills and attitudes that are critical in today's world.



▶ **MIDDLE STAGE:**
[(AGE 11 TO 14) GRADES 6 TO 8]

Here, the curriculum takes on a broader as well as deeper perspective. It focuses on a subject based curriculum with rich assignments for accentuating the learning experience. Problem-solving and inquiry based learning approaches help in fostering creativity and originality. Participatory learning, work education, exhibitions, visual and performing arts add new dimensions in enhancing learning.



▶ **SECONDARY STAGE:**
[AGE (14 TO 18) GRADES 9 TO 12]

This is an academically challenging and balanced pre- university programme of education. Designed to address the intellectual, social, emotional and physical wellbeing of students, the program is meant to be taught for over four years. The special core feature of the learning at this stage is Theory of Knowledge which stimulates critical thinking skills, social and emotional skills.



▶ **SPORTS AT GURUKUL**

The Sporting infrastructure available is comprehensive and extensive well groomed fields for football, tennis court, basketball, volley ball and athletics. The Gurukul students compete successfully every year in various sporting events and hosts major tournaments under the aegies of CBSE.

ADMISSION TEST AND ASSESSMENT

Admission to Class I and above requires students to appear for a aptitude assessment, designed to evaluate the child's academic preparedness as per the learning outcomes of the preceding class, in line with CBSE guidelines.

Admission will be considered only for students who fulfill the eligibility criteria specified for the respective stream, as per CBSE norms and school policy. Stream allocation will be subject to the student's academic performance and availability of seats.

INTERACTION AND ADMISSION CONFIRMATION

Students qualifying in the written/aptitude test will be invited for an interaction with the Principal or the Admission Counsellor, along with their parents/guardians. This interaction aims to assess the student's academic progress, aptitude, interests, and overall readiness for the class applied.

Final admission will be confirmed after successful completion of all admission procedures and verification of documents.

WITHDRAWAL AND TRANSFER CERTIFICATE (TC)

The Transfer Certificate (TC) will be issued in the month of March, after clearance of all outstanding dues. For students of Classes X and XII, the TC will be issued only after the declaration of CBSE Board Examination results, in accordance with CBSE regulations.

A written application for the TC must be submitted in the prescribed format at least 15 days in advance, as processing requires adequate time.



ADMISSION POLICY AND PROCEDURE

Admissions at Gurukul School, Bhatapara, are conducted in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and the policies laid down by the School Management.

Admission to Play School and Nursery (Balvikas I) is granted on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to the availability of seats.

Admissions to Classes I to IX and Class XI are granted based on the student's performance in a written/ aptitude test and subsequent interaction, subject to seat availability. The school reserves the right to admit students to a class deemed appropriate based on the assessment outcome.

REGISTRATION AND ISSUE OF PROSPECTUS

Parents/guardians seeking admission for their child are required to obtain the Admission Prospectus and Registration Form from the school office.

Offline Registration Procedure

Offline registration is carried out by submitting a duly filled registration form at the school office during working hours:

Time: 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Days: Monday to Saturday

The registration form must be submitted within 2-3 days of obtaining the prospectus.

Upon successful submission of the registration form, parents will be informed about the admission schedule, including the date of the written/aptitude test and the prescribed syllabus.

The presence of parents/guardians is mandatory during the admission process to complete the required formalities.
